RETURN TO NETBALL COMPETITION

GUIDELINES

CONTACT TRACING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every person, including children and dependants must check in using the Service Victoria app (CDNA QR Code link - HERE)
INSURANCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>ALL</u> participants must have current Netball Victoria state membership
HEALTH & HYGIENE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO NOT attend training /matches if you feel unwell • Wash your hands and use approved hand sanitiser before and after the training/match • Avoid high 5's, handshakes, huddles, hugs or pats on the back • Sneeze/cough into your elbow or a tissue and dispose of immediately
ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrive in full uniform with strapping done • Do not arrive at your court more than 10 minutes before your session • Leave your court immediately after your session
VENUE LIMITS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Duncan MacKinnon Reserve netball courts has a capacity limit of 500 • Only 1 spectator maximum per person may attend • Follow entry/exit signage and directions from staff (COURT MAP)
FACE MASKS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Everyone 12+ must carry a face mask at all times • Players and umpires do not need to wear a face mask during outdoor training or matches • Coaches, scorers, team officials, parents/guardians and volunteers must wear a face mask where 1.5 metre physical distancing cannot be maintained
SPACE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain 1.5 metres physical distancing when not participating • Limit crossing courts and mingling with other groups
EQUIPMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimise use of shared equipment • Do not share drink bottles, towels, phones, lip balm, sanitiser etc • CDNA will not be loaning bibs to teams • CDNA will provide match balls and sanitiser for each court • CDNA Umpires will bring scoresheets to the court each game
VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is no current vaccination requirement for participants, spectators or people required to support (coaches, umpires, supervisors, mentors etc) in community sport • Access to toilets is permitted, regardless of vaccination status
COVID SAFETY OFFICERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CDNA will provide trained COVID Safety Officers at each competition to assist members with COVID protocols and ensure compliance with mandatory checking-in • Inappropriate or anti-social behaviour towards COVID Safety Officers will not be tolerated
ENJOY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remember, this competition is purely about enjoying getting back outside and on court and everyone having fun
