- Ensure the standards of the *Fair Play Code* are applied by demonstrating the five core values that will lead to Fair Play for all – Integrity, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness and Safety.
- Be consistent, objective and courteous when making decisions.
- Maintain strict impartiality and integrity with fellow officials, players and coaches.
- Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sports and accept responsibility for your actions. This includes opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, parents and spectators.
- Be a good sport. Acknowledge all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit.
- Show respect for your team, officials and your opponents.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse.
- Recognise and respect the value and importance of volunteer committee members, officials, administrators and coaches. They give up their time and resources to provide recreational activities for players and deserve your support.

- Comply with the [Netball Australia Child Safeguarding Policy](#).
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, sexuality, cultural background or religion.
- Ensure when playing or officiating in domestic competitions that yours and your players' or fellow officials' behaviour is beyond reproach.
- Return any equipment that has been borrowed in a timely manner and satisfactory condition.

Breaching the conditions of this Code of Behaviour may be regarded as misconduct, which may result in disciplinary action.
