
# LIVE SCORING

# ALL USERS

---


Anyone who will potentially be managing, assigning scorers or scoring must download the Netball Connect app and Sign Up / Create an account.



Using this screen only allows you to be a spectator for the teams you follow and will not allow you to be found and assigned as a manager or scorer.

# SIGNING UP

The signup process is quick and easy. Download the app, open it and click 'Score/Manage/Parent' at the bottom of the screen, enter your details into the fields and click 'Sign Up'.




# ALREADY SIGNED UP?

If you've already signed up, you will see a screen similar to this one.



# ASSIGNING A MANAGER

Managers now need to be assigned to all teams. No managers = no scoring. It is a good idea to perhaps assign more than one as a safeguard if one cannot be there on the day.

\*\* Independent teams – CDNA will assign the main contact person as a manager \*\*

1. In Netball Connect, go to Match Day




2. Under 'Participating-in Competitions', choose the right competition ("Autumn 2023")



3. Under 'Competition Details', choose "Managers".



4. Click the "+ Add Manager" button.



# ASSIGNING A MANAGER

5. If the manager has a Netball Connect profile associated to your club / has followed the previous steps correctly, you can search for them and add them as an 'Existing' User. If they don't have a Netball Connect profile with your club, check with the manager to see whether they have a Netball Connect profile at all. If they do, add them as a 'New' Manager with the same email & phone number as their existing profile, as to avoid creating a 'duplicate' profile. If they don't yet have a Netball Connect profile, you can ask them to do so or also create one for them here.

# MANAGEMENT CARDS

Once Managers login to the App, they will see 'Cards' for the next **two rounds** that they are Team Manager for. They could like any one of these:



# ASSIGNING A SCORER


Team Managers assign a scorer to each game that is the team's **home** game. They must have completed the previous steps in order to appear when searched for.

(Clubs can also assign scorers in Netball Connect the same way Managers are assigned)

1. Click on the relevant game card.



2. Choose to score yourself or assign someone else.




3. Make sure to click 'Confirm'!



# ASSIGNING A SCORER

---

Scorers **must accept** their assignment in Netball Connect. Team Managers will be able to see if it has been accepted or not and know if they need to follow up.



# GETTING READY – COMPLETING ATTENDANCE

Team attendance can be recorded before the game starts (and during). Every players that takes the court must be marked.

CDNA are not recording playing positions, only matches played.



Choose “Team Selection” and your registered players that have been added to the team list should all be there.

If you need to borrow a player, click on “Add a Player” to find their name and add them. They must have paid registration anywhere in Victoria or bought a Single Game Voucher.

# GETTING READY – ANYTHING ELSE?

---

At this stage, CDNA will not be recording:


- Centre Passes
- Player positions
- Who shoots the goals
- Goal attempts
- Umpires

**\*\* PLEASE REMIND ALL ALLOCATED SCORERS THEY ARE SCORING AND ENSURE THEY HAVE A FULLY CHARGED PHONE WITH ENOUGH DATA TO LAST FOR THEIR ENTIRE GAME \*\***

# GETTING READY – IT'S NEARLY TIME!

Scorers can click on their match card and will see the following:

- an active timer will be counting down the time until the game starts.
- a reminder will be present if player attendance has not been entered yet.
- the scoring panel will remain locked until the game time starts




# SCORING THE GAME!

Once the game commences, the scorer can now enter goals. The away team scorer can keep up to date with the match on their own device.


Every time a goal is scored, click on the button.



(Be warned, it vibrates for goals!)




If a mistake is made, just click on the button and a message will pop up to confirm or cancel.



# SCORING THE GAME!

---

Once the quarter or the game ends, a pop-up message will ask you to confirm the score.



Both scorers must agree before confirming. Once confirmed, the game is ended in the system.

If there is a disagreement, the Competition Supervisor must be approached immediately.

# INJURY REPORTING

You can record an injury occurring during a game within the App. The game does not stop whilst this is done but it must be done before the game ends. This recording of an injury corroborates it with the first aider's report, both of which may be needed if claiming Netball Victoria insurance.



# LIVE SCORING FAQ'S

---

## ***Cannot find a user to assign as a manager or scorer.***

To be assigned, the user has to have created an account and be logged into the app, making sure they 'Add Competition' and add CDNA. This includes when they add their team, otherwise they will just be a spectator.

## ***Forgotten password***

Users can click "Forgot / Reset Password" and they will be asked to enter their details to be sent a password reset link. (Check trash folders!)

## ***Receiving a phone call, message or notification during the match***

It is hoped that scorers can cancel or ignore these whilst scoring. Receiving them will not impact the scoring screen or app.

## ***Scorer not showing up***

Anyone assigned as a Manager can reassign the scoring role to any other person present.

# LIVE SCORING FAQ'S

---

## ***Phone losing internet connectivity during the match***

Continue to score on the phone and the score will be updated in the system once the phone is reconnected to internet.

## ***Phone dying during the match***

- A Team Manager can re-allocate the scoring duty straight away to either themselves or someone else.
- the Association will have a very small amount of portable chargers available that must be returned immediately after the match
- a manual scoresheet may be requested from the Control Box as a very last resort. The CDNA competition supervisor will explore all other avenues before this is offered.

## ***Open teams***

It is hoped that Open teams can make suitable arrangements in advance for a non-playing scorer to attend their matches. We will be looking at other temporary options for this group briefly.

# ROUND 1

---

For our first round of the season, we will have many hands on deck to help if needed. You will be able to see either me, the Competition Supervisors, umpire supervisors, Committee members or Netball Victoria representatives if needed.

# NETBALL VICTORIA MEMBERSHIP

---

- All players, umpires and coaches MUST have a full membership every year
- You must register with Netball Connect to every competition you are take part in, but only pay the Netball Victoria Membership once a year.
- Single Game Vouchers – online only, either through club link or CDNA one
- Links from clubs – just make sure members receive and use them
- Independent players – register directly to CDNA with special given link

# MIXED DIVISIONS

---

- Two separate divisions this year
- Male on court rules (3 max on court, 1 in each area of the court)
- Minimum male rules (0 minimums, meaning all females can play)
- Age eligibility

# UNIFORMS

---

- Leeway during the grading period if uniform deliveries are delayed – must notify the Association
- Acceptable combinations of uniforms:
  - club shorts and tops
  - old club dresses
  - new club dresses
- Items NOT allowed:
  - Bike shorts on their own (Open section separate uniform rules)
  - Jewellery
  - Hard peaked caps
  - Taped nails / gloves

\*\* Fill-in players must wear the same uniform as the team \*\*

# FIRST AID

---

- CDNA are continuing to use Red Medical to provide professional First Aid personnel during our competitions
- They are NOT here to do strapping (players should be strapped before arriving)

- Last year
  - Codes of behaviour and what is expected

  - Coaches may not walk up and down the court to coach, only one third on the sideline (9's & 11's may extend to half way)
  - Procedure for any concerns
    - straight away, not at the end of the game
    - "red coat" court supervisor / competition supervisor in Control Box
